

## SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria

### Nationality

As per the SSC Combined Graduate Level Examination guidelines candidates must be a

- Citizen of India or
- The subject of Bhutan/ Nepal or
- Tibetan refugee who arrived in India prior to January 1, 1962, with the goal of living permanently in India, or
- Persons of Indian heritage who migrated to India permanently from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries Kenya, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam.

### Educational Qualification

#### Assistant Audit/ Accounts Officer

- Applicants having a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized University.
- Preferred Qualification: [Chartered Accountant](#) or Cost & Management Accountant or [Company Secretary](#) or [M.Com](#) or Masters in Business Studies or [MBA in Finance](#) or Masters in Business Economics.

#### Junior Statistical Officer (JSO)

- Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized university with at least 60% in mathematics in the 12th grade OR Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with Statistics as one of the graduating subjects

#### Statistical Investigator Grade-II

- Bachelor's degree in any field from a recognised organization, with Statistics as one of the required disciplines.

#### Other Posts

- Bachelor's Degree in any discipline ([BA](#), [B.Com](#), [B.Sc](#), [BBA](#), [BCA](#), [B.Tech](#) etc.) from a recognized University or equivalent

## SSC CGL Tier 2 exam pattern

### Points to note: Candidates can check the SSC CGL new pattern below

- Tier-II will include conducting of Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III in separate shifts, days.
- Paper-I is compulsory for all the posts.
- Paper-II will be for only those candidates who apply for the posts of Junior Statistical Officer (JSO) in the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation and who are shortlisted in Tier-I for these Posts.
- Paper-III will be for only those candidates who are shortlisted in Tier-I for Paper-III i.e. for the posts of Assistant Audit Officer/ Assistant Accounts Officer.
- Module-I of Section-III of Paper-I i.e. Computer Knowledge Test is mandatory but qualifying in nature.
- Tier-II (Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III) will consist of Objective Type, Multiple choice questions, except for Module-II of Section-III of Paper-I. The questions will be set both in English & Hindi except for English Language And Comprehension module in Section-II of Paper-I.
- There will be a negative marking of 1 mark for each wrong answer in Section-I, Section-II and Module-I of Section-III of Paper-I and of 0.50 marks for each wrong answer in Paper-II and Paper-III.
