

# SSC GD Constable Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility is one of the most important factors that every candidate must cross-check before applying. The SSC GD Constable eligibility criteria 2024 comprise various important components as mentioned below.

1. Educational Qualification
2. Physical standards
3. Nationality
4. Age limit

## Age Limit

Know about the maximum and minimum Age limits (as of 1st January 2024). For the SSC GD Candidates.

- Minimum - 18 years
- Maximum - 23 years

## Age Relaxation

Candidates belonging to reserved categories (SC, ST, OBC, etc) are eligible for age relaxation. Refer to the below table for more details about it.

Category	Age Relaxation
Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)	5 years
Other Backward Class (OBC)	3 years
Ex-Servicemen (ExS)	3 (after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age as on the date of reckoning)
Children and dependents of victims killed in the 1984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (Unreserved)	5 years
Children and dependents of victims killed in the 1984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (OBC)	8 years
Children and dependents of victims killed in the 1,984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (SC/ST)	10 years

## Education Qualification

Education Qualification is one of the most important factors that every candidate must cross-check before applying. SSC GD Constable Qualification is given below. This table shows the minimum educational qualification required for the post of SSC GD Constable:

SSC GD Constable Qualification Eligibility	
Educational	Candidates should have cleared /passed Matriculation or 10th pass from a

Qualification	recognized Board/University.
	Candidates who have not acquired the essential qualification as per the prescribed dates will not be eligible for the exam.

- There will be a negative marking of 0.25 marks for every wrong answer.
- The exam will be conducted in both Hindi and English languages.
- The candidates who clear this stage will be selected for the PMT PST.
